I would like to thank all the exhibitors for entering under me, and a big thank you to all the committee members and my very capable Ring Steward, Mr Ted Goodship, who made this show run so smoothly. The venue, Bretby Conference Centre was ideal for a show like this and the size of the ring was superb although I am sure the exhibitors would have liked it a bit smaller after all that running! It was great to see so many correct ridges which is the exception rather than the rule these days. Temperaments on the whole were excellent. It was very disappointing to see such a vast variation in type and size and some of the dogs are way too dark in colour. The standard is quite specific in the description "light wheaten to red wheaten" and mahogany does not fall into this colour description. Size needs to be watched as quite a large number of exhibits were too big and clumsy. Many of the exhibits looked wonderful standing but, regrettably, although many had good side gait, they fell apart on the away and back. Generally there are few problems with length of neck and shoulder layback but upper arms are often a little short and upright. Please watch the heads – some are way too full in cheek with weak muzzles. Feet and bone were generally good. Presentation and handling was generally very good. Thanks to all the hard working people who made the show run so well.

CLASS 1: MINOR PUPPY DOGS (5) 2 absent

1 BOYD, ROSSITER & FOX'S SONSTRAAL GABE'S PROSPECT, six month old red wheaten dog. Pleasing head but eye rims could be a bit tighter. Excellent length of neck, excellent shoulder layback. Good topline. Good depth of chest. A little heavy in bone. Good feet. Ridge a little short. Good reach and drive. May be a little large when he matures but made a very balanced picture. **BPD & BPIS.**

2 BAILEY'S MONDURI UN BEAU LION, nine month old dog. Good planes to head, eyes could be slightly darker. Good length of neck, good shoulder layback. Some forechest. Elbows could be closer to the body. Brisket could be slightly deeper. Ridge a little short. Very slightly long in loin. Correct moderate angulation. Overall a nice, moderate dog who was light on his feet.

3 APSEY'S EILACK MOTO MURUME, a seven and a half month old dark red wheaten dog. Good square muzzle. Hopefully he will grow into the excess skin on his head.. Nice dark eyes. Good shoulder layback but too short in upperarm and lacks forechest. Tailset a bit too low. When moving, lacks drive behind.

CLASS 2: PUPPY DOGS (9) 2 Absent

1 BOYD, ROSSITER & FOX'S SONSTRAAL GABE'S PROSPECT (SEE ABOVE)

2 MAITLAND JONES' MTWAPA ROHO, a nine month old dog. Needs a deeper and stronger muzzle. Good shoulder layback. Adequate length of upperarm. Brisket could be deeper. A bit too long in loin. Needs more length of second thigh. Moved fairly straight but needs to tighten up behind.

3 FRASER-WATSON'S RIGGERS DREAM OF HIAUAJIBWA, a ten and a half month old dog. A large dog with a nice square jaw. Cheeks too full. Moderate length of neck. Good depth of brisket but lacks forechest and a bit short in second thigh. A little unsteady on the move.

CLASS 3: JUNIOR DOGS (11) 1 Absent

1 VINCENT'S UMHLANDLA INJABULO FOR JEMATTI, a fourteen and a half month old dog. A pleasing head with good planes. Eyes tone with coat colour. Good length of neck with well laid back shoulders. Good depth of brisket. Good topline. Moderate hind angulation. Good sound mover.

2 WEBSTER'S NGOMA UZURI, seventeen month old dark red wheaten dog. Nice square jaw but eyes a little light in colour. Muzzle could be slightly longer. Good length of neck and good topline. Needs more length of upperarm. Brisket could be deeper. Moderate hind angulation. Needs a little more front extension.

3 WITHEY'S UMHLANDLA UBUQOTHO, litter brother to 1. Nice dark eyes, and pleasing head. Good length of neck. Moderate shoulder layback. Good topline. Brisket could be deeper. Needs a little more hind angulation. Toes in slightly in front.

CLASS 4: YEARLING DOGS (13) 4 Absent

1 WOODROW'S MIRENGO'S MUKWELA, a wheaten dog. Light eyes but tone well with coat colour. Good proportions to head. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback. Well ribbed up with good underline and topline. Good bone and nice feet. Good hind angulation. A very attractive moderate dog who moved with reach and drive and was straight and true on the away and back. **RCCD**.

2 KIRKBY & MANSFIELD'S SHINGWIDSI TSHEPA RIVA, darker red wheaten dog. Nice dark round eyes. Attractive head. Good length of neck. Moderate shoulder layback. Upperarms a bit short for length of shoulderblade. Good topline. Needs a slightly deeper brisket. Moderate hind angulation.

3 PERHAM'S MWENGA'S DUTCH COURAGE, a light wheaten dog. Slightly short in muzzle. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback. Has some forechest but brisket could be slightly deeper. Slightly long in loin. Good hind angulation. Ridge a little short. Both handler and dog were much more settled in this class.

CLASS 5: GRADUATE DOGS (4) 2 Absent

1 PATOUNAS' KYLINI IJSOKKI. A darker red wheaten dog with a lovely temperament. Slightly light in eye colour but tones with coat colour. Good length of neck and adequate shoulder layback. Good topline and depth of chest. Good hind angulation. Moved with adequate reach and drive.

2 HILL'S HYNDRIDGE MIDSOMER MAXIMUS. Pleasing head and eyes tone with coat colour. A bit too heavy in bone and body. Well ribbed up. Rather too short and upright in upperarm. Slightly high in rear and too short in second thigh. Was rather unsettled on the move.

CLASS 6: POST GRADUATE DOGS (8) 1 Absent

1 SWALES' MWANI BAKARI JW, a light red wheaten dog. Good head and nice expression. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback. Good topline but underline could be longer before cutup to loin. Good hind angulation. Ridge a little short. Moved out well with some reach and drive.

2 WITHEY'S KUWINDA SPARTAN, a bit too full in the cheeks which spoils head and expression. Moderate length of neck. Moderate shoulder layback and adequate length of upperarm. Chest could be deeper. Slightly high in rear and a bit short in second thigh. On the move lacked the reach and drive of No 1.

3 BOWLUS' SOFALA LINCOLN, a bit heavy but quite well balanced front and rear. Too much dewlap. Moderate length of neck and moderate shoulder layback. Moderate hind angulation. Ridge a little short. Did not move as well as his conformation promised.

CLASS 7: MID LIMIT DOG CLASS (5) 1 Absent

1 MORRIS' MORLINGCOURT MASTERPIECE, a red wheaten, moderate dog. A bit too full in cheek which spoils head and expression. Muzzle a bit short. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback. Good depth of chest but a little wide between elbows. Topline stable. Good hind angulation. Ridge a bit short. Moved out well.

2 BATES' BURNCOTE ARKLE SPARKLE, not enough stop, muzzle of good length. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback. Good depth of chest. A little long in loin. Topline a bit soft. Good hind angulation. A little unsteady on the away and back

3 MORRIS' NALLIM TISHLOBO, a liver nosed dog with amber eyes. Much too short in muzzle. Neck a little short. Slightly upright in shoulder and too short and upright in upperarm. Needs a slightly longer second thigh. Needs more reach and drive.

CLASS 8: LIMIT DOGS (8) 1 Absent

1 PARSONS' PRIORPARK JUBA FOR NZURI, a red wheaten dog. Muzzle a

and expression. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback. Good length of upperarm and nice bone and feet. Excellent depth of brisket. Stands slightly high in rear but moves with drive. What a grand old lady. **BV**

CLASS 12: MINOR PUPPY BITCHES (9) 1 Absent

1 HANSON & DUNN'S ILIZULU MAGICAL MOONLIGHT, a six and a half month old bitch. Very nice type with dark eyes and a pleasing expression. Lovely square jaw. Good shoulder layback. A little short in upperarm, Slightly long in loin. Has some forechest. Moderate hind angulation. Ridge a little short. Moved well for such a young pup.

2 FRASER-WATSON'S KENMILLIX FIRST LADY OF HIDAUAJIBWAS, an eight month old light wheaten bitch. Nice dark eyes but terrible ears which spoil expression. Nice length of neck and good shoulder layback. Needs more depth of chest. Slightly high in rear and a little short in second thigh.

3 NIX'S NYASSA CALUUA, a six month old bitch. A pretty bitch with nice expression. Good length of neck, moderate shoulder layback but slightly short in upperarm. Slightly long in the loin. Good hind angulation. Moved with good reach and drive but a little loose on the away and back which I hope will tighten up with age.

CLASS 13: PUPPY BITCHES (7) 0 Absent

1 NIX'S NYASSA CALUUA (see above)

2 THORNES' KWE KWE K'BEYA, a ten and a half month old red wheaten bitch with beautiful dark eyes and a pretty expression. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback but too short and upright in upperarm. Brisket needs to be deeper. A little long in the loin. Good hind angulation. Needs a little more front extension.

3 MACKFALL'S AFRICANER STORM, a year old dark red wheaten bitch. A pretty expression and good depth of muzzle. Eyes tone with coat colour. Good length of neck with good shoulder layback. Chest needs to be slightly deeper with the ribs carried well back. Slightly high in the rear and needs a little more hind angulation.

CLASS 14: JUNIOR BITCHES (16) 1 Absent

1 MACKFALL'S AFRICANER STORM (see above)

2 GOLD'S SOFALA SIMONSEZ, a pretty bitch with lovely dark eyes and expression. Good length of neck with well laid back shoulders. Slightly long in loin with a level topline. Not as feminine as 1 but a nice type nonetheless.

3 RAYMOND'S SOFALA SEQUENCE, a full litter sister to 2 also very pretty with lovely dark eyes. Not in great show condition but it also has a good length of neck and shoulder layback. Chest could be slightly deeper. Also a little long in loin.

CLASS 15: YEARLING BITCHES (10) 3 Absent

1 PARKE & GADSBY'S HESPA HIGH AS A KITE AT VELDTKAMMER, a very dark bitch of nice proportions. Nice dark eyes and good depth of muzzle. Good length of neck with good shoulder layback and moderate length of upperarms. Moderate hind angulation. Moved with determination and drive

and steady on the away and back.

2 SMITH'S ZOUGANI ZURETA, a light wheaten bitch with lovely dark eyes. Nice square jaw. A nice length of neck with well laid back shoulders, a bit short in upperarm. Moderate hind angulation. Needs a little more front extension.

3 BROADSMITH'S CHAINAMA GLORY OF SAFIKANA, a liver nosed bitch. A little too full in cheek. Nose colour could be darker. Nice round eyes. A compact bitch. Brisket could be deeper. Moderate angulation front and rear. Moved out well but needs to steady up on the away and back.

CLASS 16: GRADUATE BITCHES (11) 4 Absent

1 WHITTINGTON & MANSFIELD'S NIROMOL KIANGAZI OF HUNTERSLEAP, a very feminine, dark red wheaten bitch. A lovely head with correct planes and a nice dark eye. Elegantly arched neck of good length flowing into well laid back shoulders and a level topline. Very slightly long in loin. Good depth of brisket, good bone and feet. Nice hind angulation. Excellent reach and drive, straight coming and going and on the final go-around took complete possession of the ring and showed really well. **CCB & BIS**

2 NELSON'S ZOUGANI ZASHA, a large bitch. Light in eye but colour tones with coat. A nice square jaw. Good length of neck with good shoulder layback. A bit short in upperarm. Nice topline. Underline could be longer before cutting up to the loin. Moderate rear angulation. Light on her feet and moved out well.

3 WILCOCK'S BELSTONE ZERLINA, eye colour a bit lighter than 2. Nice head but bad ear carriage. Moderate length of neck, moderate shoulder layback. Upperarm a bit short. Could be slightly longer in loin and needs a little more hind angulation. Slightly high in rear. Lacked drive behind.

CLASS 17: POST GRADUATE BITCHES (15) 5 Absent

1 CARINS' ROOINEK RANI, a light wheaten bitch. A pretty head with nice square jaw. Eyes tone with coat colour. Nice neck and good shoulder layback. Moderate length of upperarm. Chest could be slightly deeper. Moderate hind angulation. Nice topline. Moved with reach and drive.

2 BATES' TIASTI TOO GOOD TO BE TRUE AT GUNTHWAITE, a pretty feminine head and expression. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback. Moderate length of upperarm. Brisket needs to be deeper. Ridge a little short. Needs a little more hind angulation. Moved with reach and drive but not as straight and true on the away and back.

3 DUNN'S GODOLPHINS ONE COOL CAT AT KHANANGA, a dark red wheaten bitch. A little too full in cheek and muzzle needs to be a little longer and more square. Good length of neck, good shoulder layback, nice topline. Moderate hind angulation.

CLASS 18: MID LIMIT BITCHES (8) 2 Absent

1 CAIRNS' ROOINEK RANI (SEE ABOVE)

2 SELBY'S EILACK ROYA OF CLARISMORE, medium wheaten bitch. Lovely dark eyes and pretty expression and nice square jaw. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback. Moderate length of upperarm. A little long in

loin. Ribs carried well back. Ridge a little short. Moderate hind angulation. Moved out well but needs a little more drive behind.

3 AGNEW'S CAINEBELS RED XCLUSIV FOR MWENGA (IMP), nice round eyes which are light but tone with coat colour. Needs fill under eyes. Length of neck good and shoulder layback good. Brisket could be a little deeper. Good angulation. Needs a bit more reach and drive.

CLASS 19: LIMIT BITCHES (8) 0 Absent

1 COYNES' AMISWARNO MADRIGAL WITH OZUBI, a wheaten bitch. Eyes light but tone with coat colour. Good length of neck. Good shoulder layback. A bit upright and short in upperarm. Nice long ribcage. Good topline and moderate hind angulation. Very nice on the go around but not steady enough on the away and back.

2 BOYD'S MANZILI MASKHARA, nice feminine head with pretty eye colour. Good neck and shoulder layback. Nice length and layback of upperarm. Good depth of chest. Moved quite well but not as much reach and drive as 1.

3 LAWLESS' HAYAWNI KAMAMBAA RANGI TO FAAHAC, a rather large, liver nosed bitch. Good length of neck, good shoulder layback. Too short and upright in upperarm. Nice hind angulation. Needed more front extension.

CLASS 20: OPEN BITCHES (22) 7 Absent

1 HUTCHESON & OGILVIE'S SONSTRAAL MISS MARPLE OF GABISA, a dark red wheaten bitch. Very feminine with a pretty head and expression. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback. Good length of upperarm. Nice topline but slightly long in loin. Underline could be slightly longer. Some forechest. Good bone and feet. Good reach and drive. Very light on her feet and true coming and going. **RCCB**

2 CAIRNS' ROOINEK TINTAGLIA, a lighter wheaten bitch than 1. Nice square jaw. Mask over eyes. Good length of neck and good shoulder layback. A little short in upperarm. Some forechest. Good underline. Slightly high in rear. Needs a little more drive behind.

3 McGOLDRICK'S UKUKHANYA MIDSUMMERNIGHTS DREAM, a very pretty expression and nice dark eyes. Good length of neck. Good shoulder layback. Good length of upperarm. A little long in loin and slightly high in rear. A very nice type of bitch but not shown to her best advantage. Very nice sidegait but a little loose coming and going.
